Today's Topic: *The implications for Respect for Patient's Autonomy in medical ethics: Perspectives & Reflections on Medical mandates. (23/11/2024)*

Nature of Session: Roundtable Discussion. The Forum roundtable discussions are collaborative meetings where participants have an equal opportunity to contribute. They are used to explore and exchange ideas on a specific topic.

Chatham House Rule: The Forum applies the Chatham House Rule which encourages open and inclusive dialogue in meetings. The rule states that participants should share information they receive, but not reveal the identity of the source.

Steps:

1. **Step 1: Definition of terms**, the house conducts a round of clarifications to clearly understand the definition of key terms and concepts in the topic of discussion.
2. **Step 2: Understanding of task and define goals**, the house conducts a round of clarification to clearly understand the purpose of discussion and what is intended to be the final deliverable (outcome) of the discussion.
3. **Step 3: Exposition and presentation – Phase 1**, the house conducts the first round of delivery by exposition or presentation by participants. Facilitate the discussion: Encourage active participation from everyone and summarize key points.
4. **Step 4: Exposition and presentation – Phase 2**, the house conducts the second round of delivery by exposition or presentation by participants. Facilitate the discussion: Encourage active participation from everyone and summarize key points.
5. **Step 5: Conclusions** – The house summarizes the main points raised in the discussion.
6. **Step 6: Synthesis (Document and follow up)** – Record and share the key ideas to be included in the synthesis paper of the discussion and share the results.
